**With its big spicy, red and black fruit this wine will surely make a splash wherever it is served!**

**Viticulture & Winemaking:** The fruit is sourced from Colson Canyon Vineyard (13%) and Clover Creek Vineyard (87%). Clover Creek runs along the Santa Ynez River and features warm days with cool nights, perfect for a big jammy Syrah. A portion of the fruit was aged in new oak with the remainder in neutral barrels. The wine was made by Joey Tensley and 168 cases were produced. Mr. Tensley's philosophy has always been, "source the best fruit possible, and let the vineyard speak for itself".
